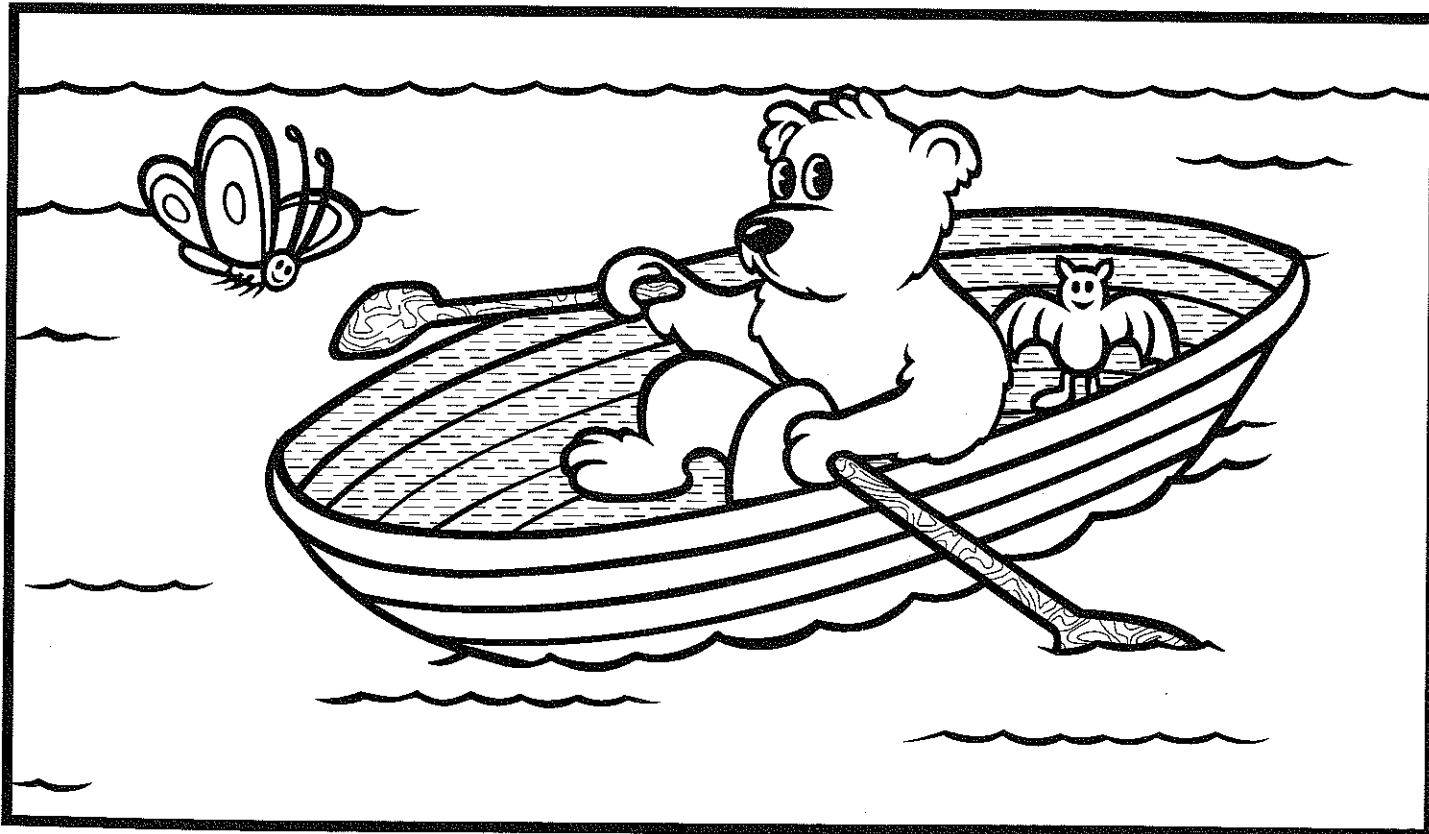
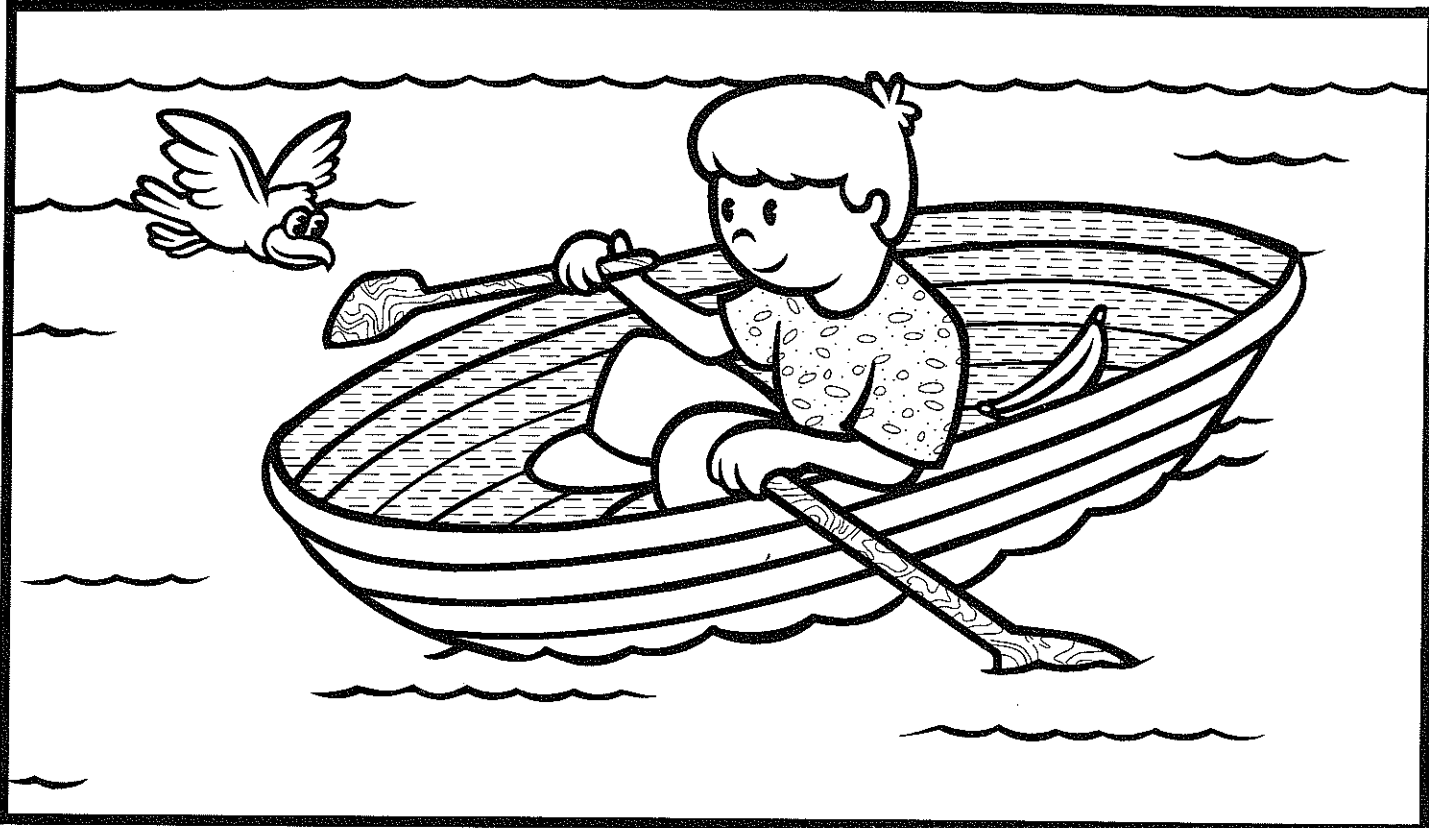


What's Different?
